### Saubermacher lays the foundation stone for „Zero Waste“ Innovative plant produces process water from industrial effluent

**Unterpremstätten – the pioneer in resource management, Saubermacher, invests in a processing plant for industrial effluents, which leaves nothing behind – except pure water.**

The time has come: the foundation stone for one of the most modern processing plants has been laid. In Unterpremstätten near Graz a plant for 6,5 million, which transforms industrial effluents into process water, is being built on the grounds of the Saubermacher recycling park. The completion is planned for April 2015.

“This zero discharge bio-physical processing plant is unique in Europe”, states Saubermachers project manager Ingomar Maunz and elaborates the reasons: “in addition to the established procedure of industrial effluent treatment we employ a new technology, consisting of membrane technology and activated carbon. This is how residual impurities are successfully held back.” Hans Roth noted: “with this plant we can once more offer a real innovation to our clients, which guarantees the complete processing of dangerous waste materials to pure water.
